One of the fundamental principles of ISO certification is that of continuous improvement; therefore, by aligning all our operations to an internationally-accredited Quality Management System, we give a firm commitment to our customers that we will provide the best quality service to meet and exceed their expectations. We will also strive to continually improve service by seeking new and more efficient ways of service delivery.

The ISO 9001:2008 Quality Management System standards provide clear instructions on the regular conducting of continuous process reviews and audits. The audits are conducted at pre-determined intervals both internally and externally, such reviews and audits will definitely bring about continuous improvement thus contributing greatly to the realization of the vision of EUC which is "To be a dynamic epicenter of excellence in training and research for service to humanity".

2. Effective Planning and Improved Decision Making

Since we now have structured processes and procedures which are documented by all our departments as per ISO standards, our staff are now empowered to make effective plans in their areas of operations. This will enhance the decision-making process through transparent and efficient operations which in turn will lead to greater customer satisfaction.

We offer 24 courses or programmes leading to the award of various degrees of the University of Nairobi.
